1) [FastWeb](#) www.fastweb.com

FastWeb is an online college scholarship listing service that is sophisticated and does a good job of matching visitors with college scholarship possibilities that match their unique user profiles. The service here is comprehensive and well-organized, and includes "over 1.3 million scholarships," along with lots of features such as a "saved favorites" section. As with most such services, FastWeb requires you to input a great deal of personal information before letting you view scholarships.

Scholarships.com boasts "3000 sources worth up to \$3 billion." It's the same drill here as with FastWeb, where you need to answer dozens of personal questions before getting the information you're seeking. Scholarships.com is a member of a number of professional organizations. There's also a good amount of general information available in this college scholarship website, even for those who don't register. A small percentage of the scholarships listed here are no longer available.
